



Observations by communities and academics:

1. The reality

Broken system in the UK led people to suffer all kinds of injustice, causing emotional, mental and/or physical suffering and/or various types of losses, **most of whom are ignored by the system and never receive any injustice.**

2. Role of mainstream press and media

A high profile incident which led an innocent person or a group of people to become victim/s is accepted by mainstream press/media, who publish/broadcast it to the whole nation. **But victims of many other similar incidents are overlooked or ignored.**

3. Role of “the system”

The system controlled by the Establishment (e.g. lawyers, police, crown prosecution service, courts, regulators etc) devotes disproportionate resources to the high profile incident that has been published by mainstream press/media **but devotes little or no resources to other similar incidents, some of which will forever remain buried.**

4. Reinforcement by mainstream press and media

Mainstream press/media then extensively publish and/or broadcast the incident accepted by the system controlled by the Establishment and highlight the fact the perpetrator/s in this particular case has been “severely punished” by a regulator and/or a court, which proves the system works and the Establishment is right. **But what about all the victims in other similar incidents overlooked or ignored by media and the system?**

Communities and academics who identified the above mentioned pattern describe it as “how the Establishment tells the world its broken system is perfectly functional”.
